NBA Recap

Yesterday was a mediocre day for the NBA model, ending the night 3-3 overall.

The model nailed the money line predictions, but the only one that provided much value was the Kings money line at +100. The No.3 seed in the Western Conference once again took care of business against the defending NBA Champs, giving the Kings an early 2-0 series lead.

Over/Under predictions got crushed as neither of the overs hit, which just goes to show how inconsistent playoff scoring can be. Philadelphia and Brooklyn combined for 222 points in Game 1 but last night combined for 180, and Golden State and Sacramento combined for 249 in Game 1 but combined for 220 in Game 2.

Spread predictions went 1-1 on the night, with the loss being Brooklyn +10 as the Nets lost by 12.
