NBA Recap

Yesterday was a decent day for the NBA model, going 6-3 overall across the nine predictions that it made.

Money line predictions were a perfect 3-0 and spread predictions were 2-1, but over/under predictions fell behind a bit and went 1-2.

One of those over/under predictions, Suns/Clippers under 227, was a 3-star play, which ended up being a loser. Los Angeles and Phoenix combined for just 105 points in the first half last night, but both offenses erupted in the second half and combined for 148 points in the final 24 minutes of play.

Luckily for us the other 3-star play, 76ers -4.5, was winner. Philadelphia almost blew it after a poor third quarter, but the better team prevailed in one of the luckier wins we have had.
